What CRBN.credit is

CRBN.credit is a carbon market intelligence terminal. It brings together data that is otherwise scattered across seven carbon registries, dozens of regulators and paid reporting services, and turns it into one structured, continuously refreshed workspace for research, due diligence, compliance and reporting.

Compliance markets such as the EU ETS publish their prices. Voluntary markets largely do not. Project records sit in seven separate registries, methodologies are assessed in different places, and regulation shifts quarter to quarter. CRBN.credit exists to close that gap without filling it with guesses.

THE PROBLEM WE SOLVE

Fragmented

Seven registries and no single, reconciled view of a project.

Opaque

Voluntary transaction prices sit behind paid reporting services.

Unchecked

Retirement claims are rarely re-verified after they are made.

If a number appears on CRBN.credit, it has a source.
If no source exists, we say so.

THREE THINGS THE PLATFORM WILL NOT DO

1

Invent a price

Where no verifiable price is published, the platform explains what drives value instead of presenting an estimate as fact.

2

Issue buy or sell calls

Tools surface evidence, scores and their sources. None of them tell you to buy, hold or avoid a credit.

3

Overstate registry data

Registry-reported facts are labelled as registry data, never presented as an independent quality verdict.

Seventeen tools, one workflow

Grouped by the job you are doing, from finding a project to reporting on it. Every tool runs on the same verified data layer.

A Find and assess a project

5 TOOLS

01 Project Auditor

Gathers every published record for one project into a single evidence-linked report. Each finding cites its source; incomplete checks are disclosed, not hidden.

02 Rating Analyzer

The CRBN Quality Index across twelve adjustable dimensions, each showing its raw value, weight and source, with the formula published in the tool.

03 Registry Lookup

Resolves any project name or serial to its full issued, retired and remaining ledger across seven registries, reconciled year by year.

04 Methodology Lab

Compares crediting methodologies by what actually happened: issuance, retirement, reversals, verification lag and ICVCM status.

05 Genius Screener

Screens the full database on your criteria plus live market signals: price moves, volume, volatility and correlation to the EU carbon price.

B Price and market

4 TOOLS

06 Benchmark Tracker

Every compliance market on one board in one currency, with spreads over time and your own retirements priced against the market.

07 Price Forecast

Scenario ranges built from measured trend and volatility. Every figure traces to a market series, a policy document or a stated formula.

08 Carbon Valuation Desk

States a price where one is published. Where none exists, explains what drives value: methodology, permanence, overhang and quality.

09 News Screener

Real, dated and linked carbon market coverage from 14 sources, filtered and summarised, never recalled from a model's memory.

C Buy, retire and hold

10 Portfolio Architect

Builds a screened portfolio from real projects and analyses it for concentration, demand and physical risk.

11 Retirement Ledger

Checks each claimed retirement against actual issuance, then re-checks it against the project's current status every time it is opened.

D Measure and report

4 TOOLS

12 Scope 3 Identifier

A Scope 3 screening inventory from US EPA and UK DESNZ emission factor tables. AI classifies spend; tonnage comes only from the tables.

13 Net Zero Generator

Reduction pathways using SBTi's Absolute Contraction Approach, country grid intensity and residual volume calculations.

14 SDG Impact

Reports only the SDG contributions a project declared to its registry, alongside national indicators. No invented impact metrics.

15 Climate Disclosure

Drafts against IFRS S2, ESRS E1 or TCFD using computed figures, with clearly labelled templates for facts no dataset holds.

E Risk and compliance

2 TOOLS

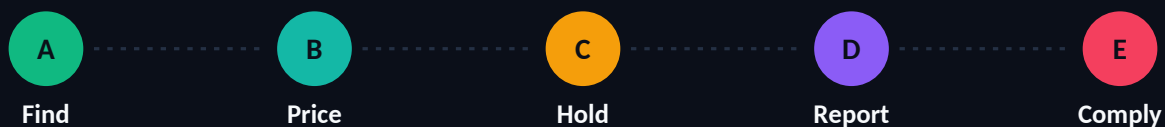
16 Risk Heatmap

Physical and governance risk by location from NASA FIRMS fire data, Global Forest Watch, USGS and the World Bank's ThinkHazard.

17 Compliance Navigator

Determines which regulations apply and when, as a threshold test against dated, individually verified rules.

ONE CONNECTED WORKFLOW



A project found in Registry Lookup can be audited, rated, priced against its market, added to a portfolio, tracked through retirement and carried into a disclosure, all inside one terminal.



A Credit Passport on every project

Each of the 11,600+ tracked projects now carries the same six checks, read from the bodies that publish them and dated, so two projects can be compared line by line.

ICVCM

ICVCM ASSESSMENT DECISIONS

Whether the programme is CCP-eligible, and what the Integrity Council decided on the methodology the project uses.

CORSIA

ICAO ELIGIBILITY DECISIONS

First phase (2024 to 2026) and second phase (2027 to 2029) tests, each check marked pass, fail or cannot be confirmed.

UN ARTICLE 6 TRACKING

The host country's authority, bilateral agreements and participation requirements, stated as country context.

Physical exposure

WORLD BANK THINKHAZARD

Wildfire, flood, drought and other hazard levels for the host country, labelled country level where no site is published.

Recorded buyers

REGISTRY RETIREMENT RECORDS

The organisations named as beneficiaries, with tonnes and the latest year, each linked to its own profile.

Declared SDGs

GOLD STANDARD REGISTRY

The goals a project declared to its registry, where the registry publishes them. Nothing is scored or inferred.

Every passport is public on its project page at crbn.credit/projects, and opens in the terminal as a Project Dossier.

The workspace around the seventeen tools

One page per project, alerts when things change, audit-ready retirement evidence, and every free tool with a history. None of it uses the monthly allowance.

01 Project Dossier

Every view of one project on one page: the record, Credit Passport and named buyers, with the Auditor, Rating, Registry, Methodology and Risk tools set to it.

02 Watchlist and alerts

Follow projects, methodologies, countries, organisations, EU ETS installations and calendar topics. Changes arrive as dated alerts, with reminders before each deadline.

03 Retirement Evidence Pack

Every retirement matched to its registry record, with ICVCM, CORSIA, Article 6 and hazard facts, summary tables and supported wording, as PDF and CSV.

04 Tools & Data

Every free tool and dataset from the public site, inside the terminal, with a history of what you viewed and ran. Never counted against the allowance.

05 Four desks

The tools arranged the way a carbon desk works: Buyer, Market, Reporting and Compliance, with Tools & Data and your workspace beside them.

06 What changed

The Overview opens with the last 30 days of changes across the market: ICVCM decisions, registry status, new calendar dates and more.

Opening a dossier, watching and building evidence packs are free.

Metered tools run only when you press Run, and a run that fails gives the unit back.

New free tools, no account needed

Six tools and datasets joined the free side of CRBN.credit. Signed in, each one also sits in the terminal under Tools & Data, with a history of what you ran.

Green Claims Checker

Tests a climate claim against the EU rules that apply from 27 September 2026, and suggests wording that holds up.

Removals Planner

The carbon removals the SBTi Net-Zero Standard V2.0 requires each year from 2035 to net zero.

Compliance Calendar

CBAM, EU ETS, ETS2, CORSIA, SBTi and green claims dates, each with its status and legal basis.

EU ETS Installation Explorer

WHY IT MATTERS NOW

27 September 2026

EU rules on environmental claims apply; offset-based neutral product claims end.

1 January 2027

CORSIA's second phase begins, and free allocation for EU CBAM sectors falls to 95%.

1 January 2028

ETS2 starts for buildings and road transport, with its own cap and price.

Every free tool is at crbn.credit, with no sign-up.

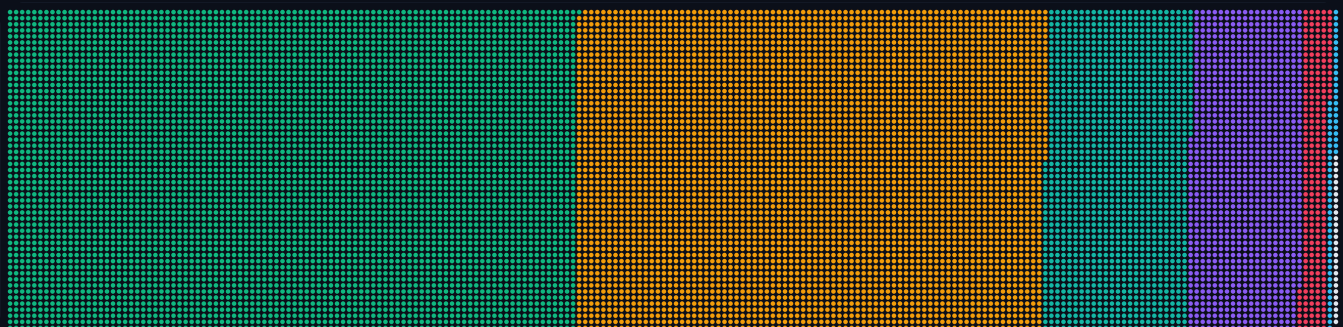

Free CBAM preparation for Indian exporters

Indian exporters of steel, aluminium, cement and fertiliser now face the EU's Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism, with the first annual declaration due **30 September 2027**. The India CBAM Center is a free set of tools built directly from the EU's definitive-period regulations. It prepares evidence; it does not verify emissions or file declarations.

A focused entry point: CRBN.credit serves carbon markets worldwide. This section exists for one urgent, specific problem.

● Embedded Emissions Calculator

Direct, precursor and indirect emissions using the EU's published method.

● India Grid Factor

Uses the Central Electricity Authority's official grid emission factor.

Organises your records into what a verifier will ask for.

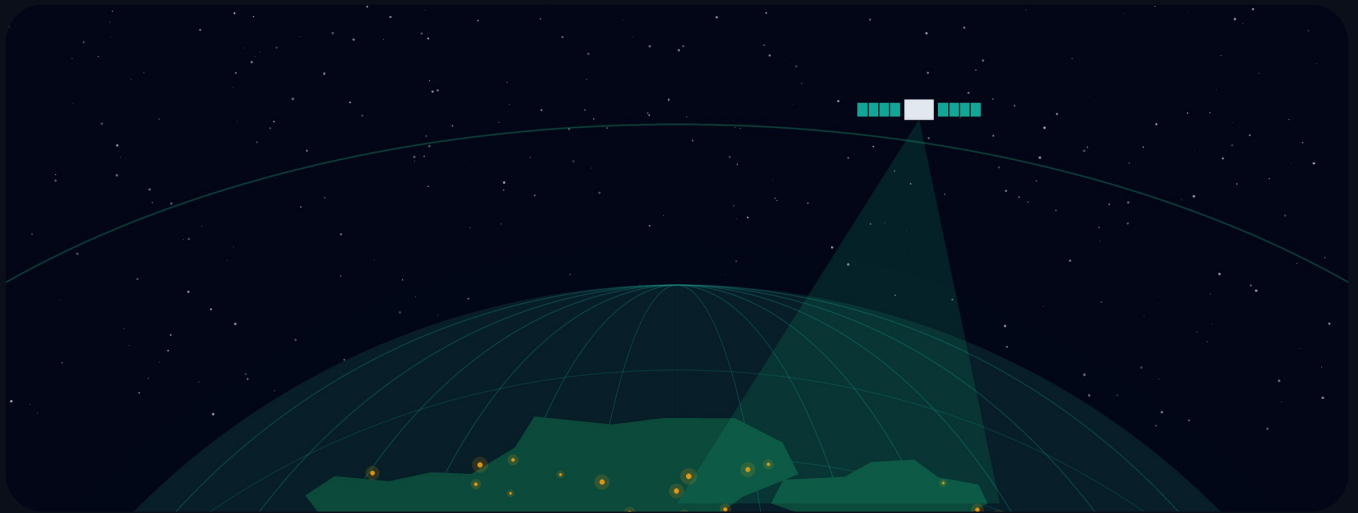

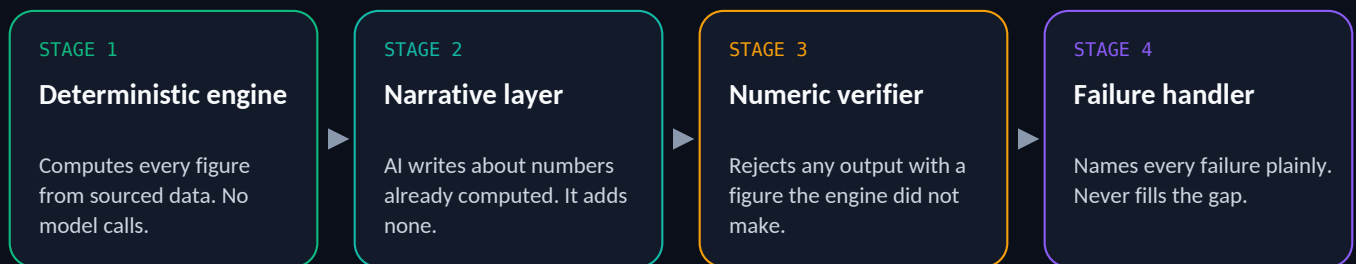

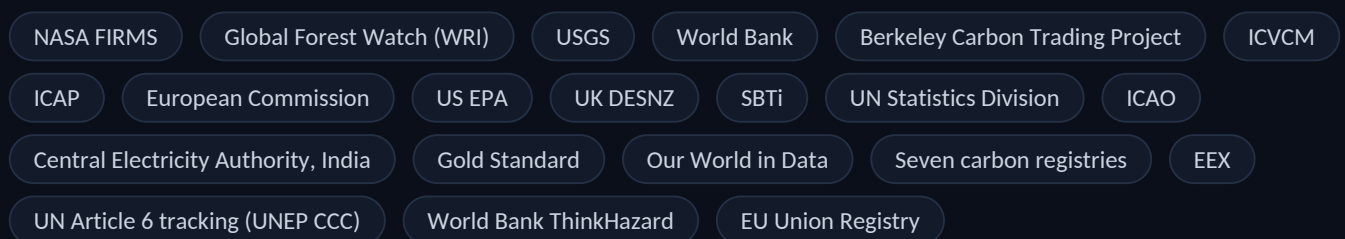
05 • THE APPROACH

Computed, not generated

Every tool follows the same four-stage pipeline. Numbers come from engines working on sourced data. AI is used only to explain those numbers in plain language, and a verifier rejects any output containing a figure the engine did not produce.

From prompt wrapper to market infrastructure

COMPLETE STAGE 01

Where we started: a prompt wrapper

The first version passed form inputs to a language model and returned whatever it wrote. It looked capable, but its numbers were not grounded in real data.

COMPLETE STAGE 02

Rebuilt on real sources

Every tool was rebuilt around deterministic engines fed by primary data from NASA, Global Forest Watch, the World Bank, Berkeley, ICVCM, ICAP, the US EPA and more, each documented in our published methodology.

LIVE NOW STAGE 03

A full intelligence terminal

Seventeen tools, 11,600+ projects across seven registries, live compliance pricing and the free India CBAM Center, with automated checks that reject any figure an engine did not compute.

IN DEVELOPMENT STAGE 04

Agentic carbon intelligence

Agentic AI on the same verified data layer: plug-and-play agents companies can connect to their own systems, supported by harness engineering for carbon markets, the verifiers, guardrails and data connections that keep every agent's output precise and traceable.

As carbon market data becomes less fragmented and more precise, CRBN.credit aims to become the most trusted marketplace in the carbon market, built on the same rule as everything before it: nothing shown without a source.
